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1 PROCEEDINGS 2 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Call the hearing to order. 3 Have the notice read, please. MS. CALDWELL: Yes, sir. Notice has been given 4 for a hearing to be held at this time and place in Docket 5 6 No. 991237, complaint by AT&T against BellSouth. 7 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. Appearances, 8 please. MS. FOSHEE: Lisa Foshee and Kip Edenfield on 9 10 behalf of BellSouth Telecommunications. MR. HATCH: Tracy Hatch appearing on behalf of 11 AT&T Communications Southern States, Inc. 12 MS. CALDWELL: Diana W. Caldwell on behalf of 13 Commission Staff. 14 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Preliminary matters. 15 MS. CALDWELL: Yes, sir. I think that the 16 parties have come to an agreement. HATCH: Commissioner Deason, late last night 20 we reached an agreement with BellSouth to resolve this 21 case, as well as several others. 22 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Several others? 23 MR. HATCH: Not in Florida, unfortunately --24 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Ah. 25

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1 MR. EDENFIELD: It was a very productive night. 2 MR. HATCH: Sorry to give you false hope. 3 What we would propose is that we continue this 4 hearing indefinitely while we prepare the documentation 5 that reflects the settlement, because it affects more than 6 just Florida. There are other jurisdictions and other 7 issues involved. 8 And so, essentially, we have come to an agreement. At the point the documentation is prepared, we 9 get it all filed, then AT&T could go ahead and dismiss its 10 case that we have here today. 11 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. 12 MS. FOSHEE: We concur in that proposal, 13 Commissioner. 14 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Staff? 15 MS. CALDWELL: Staff has no problem with that 16 17 proposal. COMMISSIONER DEASON: I know this is a silly 18 question. Do the Commissioners have any problem? 19 COMMISSIONER JACOBS: Nada. 20 COMMISSIONER CLARK: No. 21 COMMISSIONER JACOBS: Some other dockets I'd 22 23 like to see that. COMMISSIONER DEASON: Certainly, then, that 24 seems to be acceptable. And we certainly appreciate the 25 FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

parties' hard work and diligence to address these matters. And we'll be looking forward to having the actual 2 settlement file with the Commission. 3 4 When do we anticipate that occurring? 5 MR. HATCH: Because the documents require FCC 6 stuff as well as other states, I have no idea how long 7 it's going to take my federal colleagues to do their side 8 of the paperwork. I don't know. I don't anticipate it 9 would take too long. 10 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Mm-hmm. So, this docket 11 would continue? It would be open to the schedule as 12 currently contemplated would just be --13 MR. HATCH: We'd start all over. If this thing, in some truly unlikely event, would blow up, then we would 14 15 just go forward with the case, but we would notify it, and no one anticipates that happening. 16 17 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. Well, then, is 18 there anything else we need to address at this time? MR. HATCH: At this point, I don't believe so. 19 MS. CALDWELL: Staff has no further matters. 20 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Well, hearing that, this 21 hearing is adjourned. Thank you all. 22 (Hearing concluded at 9:37 a.m.) 23 24
