TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S RESPONSE TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S MOTION TO STRIKE <u>OR PROHIBIT ENTRY OF EVIDENCE</u>

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company") submits the following in response to Public Counsel's Motion to Strike portions of the exhibit attached to the rebuttal testimony of Tampa Electric witness, W. Lynn Brown:

1. Mr. Brown incorporated in his exhibit portions of the testimony on the subject of incentives relating to wholesale sales that Tampa Electric witness T. L. Hernandez had recently submitted in the fuel adjustment docket. Mr. Brown included the portions of Mr. Hernandez's testimony in his exhibit because they specifically pertain to the appropriateness of incentives for non-separated, non-firm wholesale sales and because Mr. Brown agreed with Mr. Hernandez's points and considered them worthy of consideration by the Commission in this proceeding.

2. Upon consideration of Public Counsel's objections, Tampa Electric has reviewed Mr. Brown's rebuttal testimony and concluded that it stands on its own and effectively rebuts Dr. Dismukes' direct testimony even without the portions of Mr. Brown's exhibit to which Public Counsel has objected. Consequently, and in order to move this matter forward without further argument and delay, Tampa Electric agrees to withdraw those portions of Mr. Brown's exhibit to which Public Counsel has objected and will provide the court reporter with a redacted version deleting those portions.
