SPRINT-FLORIDA, INCORPORATED'S REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER AND REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN INFORMATION PROVIDED IN RESPONSE TO STAFF'S FIRST REQUEST FOR PRODUCTION OF DOCUMENTS

Pursuant to Rule 25-22.034 and 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and Section 364.183(2), Florida Statutes, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated, ("Sprint") by and through its undersigned counsel, requests that the Florida Public Service Commission enter a Temporary Protective Order and grant Sprint's request for confidential classification covering Sprint's Responses to Staff's First Request for Production of Documents. In support, Sprint states as follows:

I. On or about February 2, 2000 Sprint provided its responses to Citizens' (also, Office fo Public Counsel) First Request for Production of Documents and Citizens' First Set of Interrogatories to the Office of the Public Counsel. On May 10, 2000 Sprint provided the responses to Staff's Discovery Requests seeking a copy of responses given to Citizens in response to Citizens First and Second Requests for Production of Documents and Citizens First Set of Interrogatories. Because Sprint has so far only given documents to the Public Counsel in

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response to the Citizens First Request for Production of Documents and Citizens First Set of Interrogatories, discovery has been provided to the Staff in response to these Discovery Requests only. Sprint previously requested Confidential Classification for these documents and reiterates this request herein for the same documents provided to Staff.

2. Section 364.183(2) provides in relevant part:

Any records provided pursuant to a discovery request for which proprietary confidential business information status is requested shall be treated by the commission and the Office of the Public Counsel and any other party subject to the public records law as confidential and shall be exempt from s. 119.07(1), pending a formal ruling on such request by the commission or the return of the records to the person providing the records.

3. Sprint considers a substantial portion of the information provided in the Responses to the Staff to be proprietary and confidential and hereby requests confidentiality for the information. Pending use at hearing or further ruling by the Commission regarding the confidential classification of the information, the information should be treated in a confidential manner pursuant to Section 364.183(2), Florida Statutes.

WHEREFORE, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated moves for entry of a Temporary Protective Order granting this request for confidential classification covering Sprint's Responses to Staff's First Request for Production of Documents.
