

This letter is sent on behalf of Gateway Technologies, Inc. ("Gateway" or "Company") as notification to the Florida Public Service Commission that the Company has entered into an agreement to become a wholly-owned subsidiary of T-NETIX, Inc. ("T-NETIX"). Closing for this transaction is anticipated to occur by June 14, 1999, subject to the required regulatory agency approvals. No changes are required to the certificate of Gateway Technologies, Inc. as the Company will not merge with T-NETIX, Inc. but will remain a separate entity.

## Parties to the Transaction:

Gateway Technologies, Inc. provides automated operator assisted calling for use by inmates of prisons, jails and other confinement institutions. Gateway was granted authority to operate within the State of Florida as a Pay Telephone Provider by order dated March 18, 1997, under Docket No. 970132-TC. The company holds Certificate No. 5102. Gateway is currently a privately held corporation organized under the laws of the State of Texas.

T-NETIX is a publicly held Colorado corporation traded on the NASDAQ exchange under the symbol TNTX. The company is a manufacturer of equipment utilized by inmate service providers. In addition, the company also provides automated operator assisted calling for use by inmates of confinement institutions in some jurisdictions. T-NETIX was granted authority to operate in the State of Florida as a Pay Telephone Provider by order dated June 11, 1993, under Docket No. PSC-96-0731-FOF-TX. The company currently provides service to customers at various locations within the state.

T-NETIX has also been granted authority as a Alternative Local Exchange Carrier effective June 25, 1996 (Docket No. PSC-96-0731-FOF-TX) and a long distance reseller effective August 17, 1993 (Certificate No. 8911-U).

## Type of Transaction:

The aforementioned transaction will be accomplished through the creation of a special subsidiary of T-NETIX, Inc. known as T-NETIX Acquisition Corp. ("Acquisition"). Acquisition will merge with and into Gateway, and Gateway will become a wholly owned subsidiary of T-NETIX. Upon completion of the transaction, T-NETIX will own 100% of the outstanding shares of Common Stock in Gateway Technologies, Inc.

This transaction will be transparent to the customers of Gateway as there will be no interruption of service or change in the management or operation of the Company. The transfer of ownership will have no effect on the Company's name, address, contact information, services, rates or terms and conditions of service. The Company will continue to market, brand and bill under the Gateway Technologies, Inc. name.
