Dear Ms. Martin:

By Order No. PSC-00-0248-PAA-WU, issued February 7, 2000, the Commission granted an increase in rates and charges for Florida Public Utilities Company's Fernandina Beach Division. This Order was made final and effective by Consumating Order No. PSC-00-0434-CO-WU, issued on March 2, 2000. As discussed on pages 36 and 40 of the PAA Order, the Commission finds a need to evaluate the effects of the utility's rate proceeding on consumption. To that end, the utility was ordered to prepare monthly reports detailing the number of customer bills rendered, the consumption billed (by usage block for the residential class) and the revenues billed. These reports shall be provided, by customer class and meter size, on a quarterly basis for a period of two years, commencing on the first billing cycle the revised rates go into effect.

According to the utility's tariff sheets on file at the Commission, the revised rates for water monthly service were effective March 1, 2000. Therefore, the reports should be provided according to the following schedule:
