## NOTICE OF INTENT TO SEEK CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or the "company") files this its Notice of Intent to Seek Confidential Classification of certain data contained in a portion of the company's Supplemental Surveillance Report Information regarding Commercial/Industrial Service Rider March 2000.

- 1. The report contains two dollar amounts which if publicly disclosed would be harmful to Tampa Electric and its customers and would contravene Tampa Electric's tariff by publicly disclosing information that is to be reviewed by the Commission and its Staff only. Tampa Electric is including with its monthly surveillance report to the Commission Staff a redacted version of the Supplemental Surveillance Report that removes the two dollar amounts in question. Attached hereto is a redacted version of the one page Supplemental Surveillance Report. The company is filing under a separate cover letter a confidential version of the Supplemental Surveillance Report information with the two dollar amounts in question highlighted.
- 2. Tampa Electric will file within twenty-one days a justification for the requested confidential classification of the two dollar amounts referred to above.

For all executed CSAs, it is estimated that the twelve months ended 3/31/00 net revenues that would have been produced by the application of Tampa Electric Company otherwise applicable standard tariff rates to the affected load would have been approximately more than the revenues actually received by Tampa Electric Company pursuant to each executed CSA.

\* This difference is offset by which is the amount received under the IIC contract for the benefit created by the interruptible provision of the agreement with the customer.
