Attached is the request of Sun Communities Finance Limited Partnership (Sun Communities or utility) for deferral of Item 34, from the May 16, 2000 Agenda Conference to the June 6, 2000 Agenda Conference. Staff agrees that this item should be deferred because the utility's attorney will be out of the country from the 14th of May to the 30th of May. If the Commission accepts staff's recommendation in its entirety, the amount of excess revenue that will accrue during this three week delay will be approximately \$3,000. The utility has agreed that any revenues ultimately determined to be "excessive" will be considered held subject to refund from the date the Commission was to consider this matter (May 16, 2000), until the June 6, 2000 Agenda Conference.
