Issue 2: Should Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc.'s application for amendment of Water Certificate No. 363-W be granted?

Recommendation: Yes. Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc.'s application for an amendment to expand its territory should be granted, as described in Attachment A of staff's May 4, 2000 memorandum. The incorrect territory description, as described in Attachment A, to Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc.'s Water Certificate No. 363-W should be deleted. Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc. should charge the customers in the territory added herein the rates and charges contained in its tariff until authorized to change by this Commission in a subsequent proceeding.
