Dear Mr. Brown:

The Commission's Division of Records and Reporting forwarded a copy of your letter dated March 20, requesting cancellation of your pay telephone certificate. You advised that you were no longer in business.

I cannot recommend voluntary cancellation of a certificate when there is an outstanding balance of regulatory assessment fees (RAFs). You mailed the \$50.00 fee for 1998 on February 2, 1999, but you did not pay the statutory penalty and interest charges of \$3.00. In addition, you mailed \$0.20 of the fee for 1999 on March 15. Since there is a minimum fee of \$50.00, you owe the balance of \$49.80, plus penalty and interest charges of \$12.00, if your check is postmarked in May 2000. This means there is a total outstanding balance of \$64.80 that must be paid before I can recommend a voluntary cancellation of your certificate.

As information, until the Commission is notified in writing that a company wishes to cancel its certificate, the RAF is due on that certificate if the certificate is active for any day during a calendar year. This means that not only must the \$64.80 be paid, but that you are also responsible for the 2000 RAF since the Commission was not notified until March 22, 2000.

1 am enclosing a copy of Rule 25-24.514, F.A.C., which explains how to request voluntary cancellation. The company would need to first pay the past due amount in full, and then write the Commission another letter advising when the 2000 RAF fee will be paid. Or, another option would be to pay the 2000 fee when you pay the past due amount. 1. 20 11
