By Order No. PSC-98-1642-FOF-WS, issued December 7, 1998, Docket No. 980767-WS was to remain open pending final disposition of all issues in Docket Nos. 980057-WU and 980943-WS. Once those dockets had been closed, Certificates Nos. 072-W and 064-S were to be canceled and Docket No. 980767-WS was to be administratively closed.

Docket No. 980057-WU was closed February 23, 1999, by Order No. PSC-99-0390-FOF-WU. By memorandum dated May 25, 2000, staff indicated that all pending issues in Docket No. 980943-WS were resolved and the docket should be administratively closed.

This memo serves as staff's request that Certificates Nos. 072-W and 064-S be canceled and Docket No. 980767-WS be administratively closed, as well. The effective date for the cancellation of certificates should be the date the utility became non-jurisdictional which was June 30, 1998.
