Summary

Lake Grove Utilities Inc. has applied to the Public Service Commission for an amendment of its certificate to provide water and wastewater service in Lake County, Florida. The expansion area is approximately 160 acres of real property located in the County. Staff has no objections to the proposed amendment.

Description of Proposed Expansion

The property contains a campground with 363 water service connections and 229 sewer service connections along with additional vacant land. The owner of the property has future plans to develop the area into a residential community of approximately 350 building lots. The property is to be developed in 2 or more phases with the first phase consisting of approximately 194 building lots.

Need For Service

The proposed additional territory is a 160 acre property that is planned to be developed soon. The property owner wishes to utilize water, reclaimed water, and sewer services provided by Lake Grove Utilities, Inc. (LGUI). LGUI is the owner and operator of water and reclaimed water production and distribution facilities, and sewer collection and disposal facilities which are in close proximity to the property. Service will be needed in the new area approximately one year from the date of this application, based on the development plans of the property owner.

The water and wastewater service territory amendment being proposed by this application will service a campground at the present and a residential community in the near future. At maximum density under current regulations, 350 single family residences will be added to the system as a result of future residential development. Further expansions to the Lake Grove Utilities potable water and wastewater systems will be required to provide service to the area proposed. Permits for the proposed expansion have already been granted by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

Consistency with County's Comprehensive Plan

The proposed expansion area is located in Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 26 East east of the right-of-way-lane of US Highway 27. The proposed expansion area is designated at up to 4du/ac (Urban Exp.). The plans for extending water and sewer in this area are logical and consistent based on the data given.

Local Government Concerns

Further expansions to the Lake Grove Utilities potable water and wastewater systems will be required to provide service to the area proposed. Permits for the proposed expansion have already been granted by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection. Expansions to the systems should be in place well before development to the property is completed. Lake County planning staff was contacted in regards to the amendment and voiced no concerns to the application to expand the Lake Grove Utilities, Inc., service territory.

Conclusion and Recommendation

The proposed amendment to the service territory of the Lake Grove Utilities Company will provide water and sanitary sewer and facilities and services to future developments in the proposed expansion territory. Staff does not recommend any objections to the application.
