This is a follow up to our teleptone conversation concerning nonpayment of the regulatory assessment fee (RAF). As information, the fee is due each year by January 30 for the previous year, unless the 30th falls on a weekend, then the due date is the next working day. For example, the 1998 fee was due February 1, 1999 and the 1999 fee was due January 31, 2000.

I have confirmed that the $\$ 50.00$ fee for 1998 was paid on October 15, 1999, however, the company did not pay the $\$ 12.50$ penalty and $\$ 4.50$ interest charge for a total due of $\$ 17.00$. In addition, our records show that the 1999 fee, plus accrued penaity and interest, has not been paid yet. The amount due is $.0015 \%$ of the company's net intrastate operating revenue for the period covered, or $\$ 50.00$, whichever is greater. If the company owes the minimum for 1999 , and if it is paid by March 30 , the company needs to pay $\$ 56.00$ ( $\$ 50.00$ fee, $\$ 5.00$ penalty, and $\$ 1.00$ interest). The 1999 RAF fom is attached.

If the company wishes to keep its certificate active, it needs to make a settlement offer to resolve this docket. In other cases dealing with this rule violation, the Commission has accepted a $\$ 100$ settlement in lieu of the $\$ 500$ fine imposed. The settlement letter needs to include the following:

- Docket number:
- Enclose a check for all past due amounts;
- Statement that it has taken steps to prevent future late payments of the regulatory assessment fees; and
- Make a specific monetary settlement.

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Any settlement offer should be addressed to Ms. Blanca Bayó, Director, Division of Records and Reporting, Florida Public Service Commission, at the above address. The proposed settlement amount should not be paid at this time. It will become due after the Commissioners vote on this issue.

Instructions For Filing Regulatory Assessment Fee Remin
(Pay Telephone Service Provider)

1. WHEN TO FILE: For companies which owed a total of $\$ 10,000$ or more of assessment fee for the preceding calendar year this Regulatory Assessment Fee Return and payment must be filed or postmarked:

On or before July 30 for the six-month period January 1 through June 30, AND
On or before Januany 30 for the six-month period July 1 through December 31 .
For companies which owed a total of less than $\$ 10,000$ of assessment fee for the preceding calendar year. this Regularory
Assessment fee Renurn and payment must be filed or postmarked:
On or before January 30 for the prior iwelve-month period January 1 through Deceraber 31 .
However, if July 30 or January 30 falis on a Samrday, Sunday, or holiday, the Regulatory Assessment Fee may be filed or postmarked on the next business day, withour penalty.
2. FEES: Each company shall pay 0.0015 of its gross operating revenues derived from intrastate business, as referenced in Rule 25-4.0161(1),F.A.C. Gross Operating Revenues are defined as the total revenues before expenses. Gross Intrastate Operating Revenues are defined as revenues from calls orginating and terminating within Florida. Do not deduct any expenses, taxes, or uncollectibles from these amounts other than the amount on Line 3 .

On Lite 3, deduct any amount paid to another telecommunications company for the use of any telecommunications network (including installation charges) to provide service to its customers. Do nol deduct any faxes. federal subscriber line charger, interstate long distance access charges, or amounts paid for nonregulazed sericus such as voice mail, inside wire maintenance, or equipment purchases/rentals. DEDUCTIONS MUST BE INTRASTATE ONLY AND MUST BE VERHFIABLE.
3. FAILURE TO FILE BY DUE DATE: Failure to file a renarn by the established due date will result in a penalyy being added to the amount of fee due, $5 \%$ for each 30 days or fraction thereof, not 10 exceed a total penalty of $25 \%$ (Line 6 ). In addition, interest shall be added in the amount of $1 \%$ for each 30 days or fraction thereof, not to exceed a total of $12 \%$ per year (Line 7). A Regularory Assessment Fee Retum must be completed, signed, and filed even if there are no revenues to report or if the minimum amount is due.

> When a compary fails to timely fle a Regulatory Assessment Fee Resum, the Commission has the authority to order the company to pay a penaloy andlor cancel the company's certificate. The company will have an opportunity to respond to any proposed Commission action.

4 EXTENSION: A request for an extension of time up to 30 days may be made by filing the enclosed Request for Extension to File Regulatory Assessment Fee Rerurn form (PSC/ADM-124), two weeks prior to the filing date. When an extension is granted, a charge shall be added to the amount due:
$0.75 \%$ of the fee to be remitted for an extension of 15 days or less, or
$1.5 \%$ of the fee for an extension of 16 to 30 days.

In lieu of paying the charges outlined above, a company may file a return and remit payment based upon estimated gross operaring revenues. If such return is filed by the nommal due date, the company shall be granted a 30 -day extension period in whith to file and remit the actual fee due without paying the above charges, provided the estimated fee payment remitted is at least $90 \%$ of the acrual fee due for the period. An automatic 30 -day extension to file an actual return may be obtained by checking the "Estimated Renum" space in the top left-hand comer on the reverse side.
5 EEE ADIUSTMENTS: You will be notified as to the amoun and reason for any adjustment. Penalty and interest charges may be applicable to additional amounts owed the Commission by reason of the adjustment. The company may file a writen request for a refind of any overpayments. The request should be directed to Fiscal Services at the below-referenced address.
