Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

Recommendation: No. If staff's recommendation in Issue 1 is approved, this docket should remain open pending resolution of the show cause proceeding. Push Button Paging must respond to the original show cause order within 21 days of the issuance of this Order denying the settlement. If Push Button Paging fails to respond to the Order to Show Cause and the fine is not received within ten business days after the expiration of the show cause response period, then Certificate No. 5727 should be canceled and this docket should be closed administratively.
