Dear Mr. Stone:

Thank you for your participation at the meeting held on Friday, May 12, 2000, concerning the proposed territorial policy statements.

At the meeting, staff suggested the use of a two-pronged test to determine "de minimis" cost to serve by each utility upon a request for new service. The test would take into account both the cost to provide service in comparison to the projected revenues from the new service and the proximity of the appropriate facilities to the new customer. The test would also facilitate the determination of "substantially equal" as used in Rule 25-6.0441(2)(d).

At the meeting, it was agreed that both parties would file respective comments on the proposed two-pronged test by July 1, 2000. However, due to scheduling concerns, we now request that responses be provided on or before July 10, 2000.
