On September 23, 1999, I called you concerning the balance of the 1998 Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF). You asked me to fax you a bill to (954) 735-3826, which I faxed on the same date. You advised that you would pay it immediately upon receipt of the bill.

I opened this docket on December 23, 1999 since the Commission had not received the 1998 balance, plus the statutory penalty and interest charges for 1992, 1994, 1995, and 1998. On April 26, 2000, Order No. PSC-00-0822-PAA-TC was issued, which imposed a \$500 fine or canceled your pay telephone certificate.

On May 1, 2000, you called and advised that you wanted to keep your certificate active and asked me to mail information on how to resolve this docket. I mailed the 1999 RAF return, along with information on how to make a settlement offer on May 2. On May 16, the Commission received two money orders from you. One money order was in the amount of \$126.59, which paid the past due amount in full. The other money order was in the amount of \$50.00. Since you did not advise what this \$50.00 was for, the Commission's Division of Administration has credited your account with \$50.00 toward the 2000 fee. You also included a note that stated "I will make sure all settlements will be paid on the right timing."
