TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6), moves the Commission for the entry of a protective order to ensure the continued confidentiality of information contained in documents which the Florida Industrial Power Users Group ("FIPUG") has requested Tampa Electric to produce in this proceeding and, as grounds therefor, says:

- 1. On May 30, 2000 Tampa Electric filed its Objections, Motion for Protective Order and Written Response to FIPUG's First Set of Requests for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-2) preliminarily asking the Commission for a protective order pending the company's review of the documents described in FIPUG's request. Tampa Electric has completed that review and submit this Motion for Protective Order to specifically identify the documents which need to be protected on a confidential basis.
- 2. FIPUG's Requests for Production of Documents (Nos. 1-2), propounded and served by hand delivery on May 19, 2000 request a significant amount of information from Tampa Electric which is proprietary confidential business information the public disclosure of which would be harmful to Tampa Electric and its general body of ratepayers. Much of the information consists of sensitive market based pricing data and would supply a wealth of

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knowledge with regard to Tampa Electric's sources of negotiated power purchases and the prices paid for such purchases. The documents in question also disclose negotiated rates for power sold to Tampa Electric's wholesale customers. Public disclosure of this information would be harmful to Tampa Electric's competitive interests and that harm would be carried through to the direct detriment of Tampa Electric's general body of ratepayers.

- 3. The confidential information discloses on and hour-by-hour basis Tampa Electric's cost of generation as well as the cost of generation of other suppliers who sell power to Tampa Electric. Public disclosure of this type of information would adversely affect Tampa Electric's ability to compete in the wholesale market because its competitors could use this information to model Tampa Electric's system operations as well as the system operations of suppliers who sell power to Tampa Electric.
- 4. Attached hereto is a table of the information accumulated by Tampa Electric in response to FIPUG's requests Nos. 1 and 2. The document pages total 3,844 with a significant portion of the pages containing confidential information. Documents for which a claim of confidentiality is made are so designated on the attached table.
- 5. Tampa Electric has prepared and furnished FIPUG with a draft Non-Disclosure Agreement patterned after the one which FIPUG executed in the reserve margin docket in order to have access to similar information in that proceeding. FIPUG should be required to sign the Non-Disclosure Agreement in advance of having access to any of the documents designated confidential in the enclosed table. All of the documents are in Tallahassee and are available for FIPUG to review upon its execution of the Non-Disclosure Agreement.

WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company moves the Commission for entry of an order conditioning FIPUG's access to the documents designated as confidential in the attached table upon FIPUG's prior execution of the Non-Disclosure Agreement provided by counsel for Tampa

Electric.
