<u>Issue 1</u>: Should the Commission accept the settlement offer proposed by NeTel, Inc. d/b/a Tel3 to resolve the apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies?

<u>Recommendation</u>: No. The Commission should not accept NeTel, Inc. d/b/a Tel3's settlement offer, which proposed to pay the 1999 RAF, statutory penalty and interest charges on April 10, 2000, a \$100 contribution, and pay future RAFs on a timely basis. The company has already failed to honor its agreement by not paying the 1999 RAFs on April 10. The RAFs remain unpaid as of May 23, 2000. Therefore, Order No. PSC-99-2441-PAA-TI proposing to cancel NeTel, Inc. d/b/a Tel3's IXC certificate should be rendered a Final Order. If the company fails to pay in full the required 1999 regulatory assessment fee, including statutory penalty and interest charges, and fine within five business days of the issuance of the Order
