Issue 1: Should the Commission grant the companies listed on page 4 of staff's 6/8/00 memorandum a voluntary cancellation of their pay telephone certificates?

Recommendation: No. The Commission should not grant each company a voluntary cancellation of its pay telephone certificate. The Commission should cancel the companies listed on page 4 on its own motion, effective on the date of issuance of the Consummating Order.

Issue 2: Should these dockets be closed?

Recommendation: Yes. If the Commission approves or modifies staff's recommendation on Issue 1, these dockets should be closed upon receipt of the fees or cancellation of the certificate, unless a person whose substantial interests are affected by the Commission's decision files a protest within 21 days of the issuance of the proposed agency action order. If the Commission denies staff's recommendation on Issue 1, these dockets should be closed administratively. A protest in one docket should not prevent the action in a separate docket from becoming final.
