

Issue 2: Should Shangri-La's Motion for Reconsideration of Order No. PSC-00-0629-PCO-WS and to Establish Burden of Proof be granted?

Recommendation: Staff recommends that it is unnecessary to rule upon the reconsideration portion of Shangri-La's Motion for Reconsideration of Order No. PSC-00-0629-PCO-WS and to Establish Burden of Proof because the parties are in agreement as to who should file testimony first. Therefore, staff recommends that Order No. PSC-00-0629-PCO-WS should be modified to reflect that OPC will file its testimony first. Staff recommends that Shangri-La's request to establish the burden should be denied. In addition, staff recommends that the ultimate burden of proof rests with the utility.
