The Citizens of the State of Florida, through their attorney, the Public Counsel, pursuant to Section 350.0611, Florida Statutes, hereby file this Notice of Intervention in the above referenced docket. The Citizens submit:

- (a) The agency affected is: The Florida Public Service Commission, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850.
- (b) This intervenor is: The Office of the Public Counsel, 111 W. Madison Street, Room 812, Claude Pepper Building, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1400, (850) 488-9330.
- (c) Intervenor has received from the PSC copies of various submissions in this docket.
 - (d) Intervenor disputes:
 - (i) whether the rate base sought by Aloha Utilities properly reflects the actual reasonable cost of items used and useful in the public service; and
 - (ii) whether the O&M expenses sought by Aloha Utilities properly reflect the actual reasonable cost to provide utility service.

- (e) Intervenor alleges that:
 - the rate base sought by Aloha overstates the actual reasonable
 cost of items used and useful in the public service;
 - (ii) O&M expenses overstate the actual reasonable cost to provide utility service; and
 - (iii) because both capital costs and expenses are overstasted, the rates being sought by Aloha Utilities are excessive.
- (f) Section 367.081, Florida Statues, prohibits a utility from collecting excessive or unreasonable rates.
- (g) As relief, this Intervenor seeks the Commission to set rates at a reasonable level.

WHEREFORE, the Citizens of the State of Florida hereby give notice of their intervention in this docket.
