RE: Local Exchange Telecommunication Company Pay Telephone Certification in Florida

Dear Mr. McCabe:

It has been brought to our attention that TDS Telecom/Quincy Telephone is providing pay telephone services without a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity from this Commission to operate as a pay telephone service provider in Florida. The Commission repealed the LEC pay phone Rule 25-4.076, Florida Administrative Code, February 1, 1999, based on a ruling by the Federal Communications Commission in FCC Order 96-388, adopted September 20, 1996, in which LEC payphones were reclassified as customer premises equipment. Local Exchange Telecommunications Companies providing pay telephone service in Florida now operate under the Commission's pay telephone rules, set forth in Section 25-24-500 through 25-24.520, Florida Administrative Code.

Since TDS Telecom/Quincy Telephone is not certificated to provide pay telephone services in Florida, TDS Telecom/Quincy Telephone cannot bill or collect for any pay telephone services provided in Florida. Therefore, it is imperative that TDS Telecom/Quincy Telephone complete the enclosed pay telephone service application and return it by July 1, 2000. Failure to respond in a timely manner may result in legal action for being in violation of Rule 25-24.510, Florida Administrative Code, Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity Required.


