BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S MOTION FOR A TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER FOR CITIZENS' THIRD SET OF INTERROGATORIES

COMES NOW BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth" or "Company"), and files, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), Florida Administrative Code, its Motion for Temporary Protective Order in connection with its Responses to Florida's Citizens' ("Citizens") Third Set of Interrogatories, dated June 16, 2000.

On July 19, 2000, BellSouth served its Responses to Citizens' Third Set of Interrogatories, which are deemed to be confidential and proprietary by BellSouth. The information that will be conveyed to and reviewed by Citizens' in connection with the responses to these interrogatories includes proprietary, confidential business information which should not be publicly disclosed. Thus, pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(6)(c), Florida Administrative Code, BellSouth moves that the Prehearing Officer issue a Temporary Protective Order exempting this information from § 119.07(1), Florida Statutes. The proprietary information in question includes, but is not limited to, marketing information. Once Citizens' notifies BellSouth that any of the proprietary documents are to be used in a proceeding for the Commission, BellSouth will file a detailed Motion for

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Protective Order specifically addressing each of the documents identified in accordance with Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code.

WHEREFORE, BellSouth respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion for Temporary Protective Order in regard to its Responses to Citizens' Third Set of Interrogatories.
