BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files its Request For Confidential Classification, and states the following:

- 1. On July 5, 2000, BellSouth filed its Responses to the Seventh Request for the Production of Documents filed in this docket by the Florida Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff"). Some of the information responsive to Production Requests Nos. 31 and 38 is confidential and proprietary. At the same time, BellSouth filed a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification.

This information is valuable, it is used by BellSouth in conducting its business and BellSouth strives to keep it secret. Therefore, such information is a trade secret which should be classified as proprietary, confidential business information exempt from the Open Records Act.
- 3. This information contains competitive business information. This information if released would be unfair to BellSouth for it would allow the competition to have free access to information which was developed at an expense to BellSouth. Competitors would then have an advantage in bidding for such business since they would have few, if any, expenses such as research and development to recover, and would bid below BellSouth's cost level. Accordingly, this information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 364.183.
