RE: Docket No. 991931-EG - Determination of Appropriate Method of Recovery for the Last Core of Nuclear Fuel for Florida

Power & Light Company and Florida Power Corporation.

On August 24, 2000, staff filed its recommendation in the above-referenced docket for consideration at the Commission's September 5, 2000, Agenda Conference (Item 22). The recommendation concerns the appropriate method for recovery of costs associated with the last core of nuclear fuel for Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) and Florida Power Corporation (FPC). FPL and FPC both requested cost recovery through the fuel adjustment clause. Staff recommended recovery through an unfunded reserve of nuclear decommissioning. This morning, we received a request from FPL to this item until the conclusion of FPL's nuclear decommissioning accrual study update at the end of this year. A copy of FPL's request is attached hereto. FPC has indicated that it does not object to deferral of this item. Both FPL and FPC have indicated that they will not seek recovery for any last core costs through the fuel clause for the 2001 recovery period.

In light of FPL's request, staff requests approval to withdraw its recommendation. Staff notes that FPL will file a nuclear decommissioning study at the end of this year, but the conclusion of that study will not occur until the fourth quarter of 2001. Staff would like the opportunity to bring this issue to the tor/Technical

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REPORTING Commission if it appears appropriate to do so upon review of FPL's decommissioning study, rather than wait for the conclusion of that study at the end of 2001.
