I do hereby object to the application of United Water Florida, Inc, to extend their service area located in Nassau County, Florida as set forth in the legal notice on page 6C of the Fernandina Beach Newsleader dated 8/30/2000, on the following grounds.

- 1. The area sought in the extension is too broad.
- 2. The area sought in the extension is low density. There is no demand yet for this service.
- 3. If granted, this service will contribute to "urban sprawl" which is a violation of our Comprehensive Plan.
- 4. This service is being sought to accommodate one developer and if granted may, now or in the future, create incredible financial hardships for every man, woman and child in my community.
- 5. No information has been given to the public or the residents in the area affected as to the cost, the benefits, the timetable or any other details. Ms. Janice Sanderson has spent the last 30 days trying to access the above information for my community and has been given conflicting information from our county coordinator, county planner, county engineer, Health Department, county commissioners, and United Water Florida. We do not know who or what to believe.
