Enclosed herewith is a copy of the Amended Petition for Leave to Intervene by Sentry Industries, Inc., which I have filed today. This filing corrects a regrettable imprecision by the undersigned, contained in Sentry's September 18 Petition for Leave to Intervene, as well as earlier motions by Odyssey regarding the sequence of events during the negotiations between my clients and Tampa Electric for Odyssey's CISR rate.

Properly put, Sentry entered into a Confidentiality and Non-Disclosure Agreement with Tampa Electric in March, 1998; Sentry thereafter submitted proprietary confidential business information thereunder to Tampa Electric; Odyssey, incorporated as a Delaware corporation on June 30, 1998, thereafter submitted proprietary confidential business information to Tampa Electric with a reasonable expectation that such information would be protected by a confidentiality provision under a Contract Service Agreement; the Commission approved Tampa Electric's CISR tariff, including the confidentiality provision thereof; and Tampa Electric and Odyssey entered into a Contract Service Agreement with the confidentiality provision of the CISR tariff. I believe that the confidentiality provision of the CISR tariff and CSA fairly applies to the "information supplied by [Odyssey] ... as a result of negotiations or information requests by [Tampa Electric]," while the confidentiality provisions of the March 2000 Agreement between Sentry and Tampa Electric fairly applies to the proprietary information provided by Sentry thereunder.

Please be assured that my earlier imprecision on this matter was conveyed in good faith based on my own imperfect understanding of the course of negotiations between my clients and Tampa Electric for a CISR rate for Odyssey's Tampa plant.

Please note that as indicated in the Amended Petition, it is my understanding that the March 1998 Agreement between Sentry and Tampa Electric was included in Tampa Electric's March 10, 2000 submittal to the Commission, at Bates-stamped pages 130-0
