Indiantown Gas Company of Florida (IGC or "the Company"), by and through its undersigned officer, offers the following as its Statement of Issues and Positions for consideration at the forthcoming hearing on Purchased Gas Adjustment:

<u>Issue No. 1:</u> What is the Company's total net true-up amount for the period January 2000 through December 2000?

IGC Position: An underrecovery of \$7,468.

<u>Issue No.2:</u> What is the Company's estimated net true-up amount to be collected during January 2000 through December 2000?

IGC Position: An overrecovery of \$7,321.

<u>Issue No. 3:</u> What are the estimated therm sales for the projected period January 2001 through December 2001?

IGC Position: 5,560,700 therms.

<u>Issue No 4:</u> What should the maximum levelized purchased gas cost factor be for IGC for the period January 2001 through December 2001? <u>IGC Position:</u> \$0.83729 per therm.
