3. I am a very small company with only 3 telephones in operation at the close of 1999. My total Gross operating Revenue for the year was \$812.10. 1999 RAF's are \$1.22. Penalty for Late Payment (25% max) owed is \$0.31. Interest for late payment (12% yr) is \$0.11. The max total 1999 RAF owed is \$1.64 (\$1.22 + \$0.32 + \$0.15); however, as provided in section 364.336 Florida Statutes, the minimum annual fee is \$50.00.


