# PEOPLES GAS SYSTEM'S PRELIMINARY STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Peoples Gas System ("PGS") hereby submits its preliminary statement of issues and positions to be taken up at the hearing now scheduled to begin on November 20, 2000 in this docket.

Issue 1: What is the appropriate final purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period January 1999 through December 1999?

**PGS's Position**:

\$866,759 underrecovery.

Issue 2: What is the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the period January 2000 through December 2000?

**PGS's Position**:

\$2,939,165 underrecovery.

<u>Issue 3</u>: What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be refunded in the January 2001 - December 2001 period?

PGS's Position:

\$3,805,923 underrecovery.

Issue 4: What is the appropriate levelized purchased gas recovery (cap) factor to be charged during the period January 2001 through December 2001?

**PGS's Position**:

71.171 cents per therm.

<u>Issue 5</u>: What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment charge for billing purposes?

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**PGS's Position:** 

The factor should be effective for all meter readings on or after January 1, 2001, beginning with the first or applicable billing cycle for the period January 2001 through December 2001.
