The following information is provided in response to your request for information regarding Tampa Electric's costs projected in 2001 related to the particulate matter continuous emissions monitor ("PM CEM") project filed for recovery through the Environmental Cost Recovery Clause ("ECRC"). The project is just beginning and Tampa Electric has not yet prepared specifications nor has the company solicited bids for this project at this time. Tampa Electric has, however, spoken to two vendors of this type of equipment to obtain preliminary quotations for use in the budgeting for capital work in 2001. The specific PM CEM material costs were estimated by taking an average of the verbal budgetary estimates provided by the two vendors. Additional costs were estimated based upon the company's understanding of the installation and operations of similar equipment as well as past experience with similar monitoring equipment. Listed below is the preliminary estimate and breakdown of costs estimated in 2001 for the PM CEM.
