As we discussed Panda Leesburg and Panda Midway filed Motions to Abate yesterday similar to the motions to abate which have been filed by Okeechobse Generating Company, L.L.C. (OGC) (Docket No. 991462-EU) and Duke Energy St. Lucie, L.L.C. (Docket No. 000612-EU).

It is my understanding that OGC has requested that Item No. 26 on Tuesday, November 7, 2000 agenda regarding the dismissal of OGC's and Panda's need determination petitions be deferred. Panda supports this request and would ask that Item No. 26 be deferred until the November 28, 2000 agenda and consolidated with consideration of Panda's motions to abate.

It is my understanding that Duke Energy's motion to abate will be considered by the Commission at its November 28th agenda. All of these need determination dockets are procedurally in the same posture and all have essentially alleged the same facts in support of their respective motions to abate. It only makes sense that all of the motions to abate should be considered together along with all associated motions to dismiss based on the Florida Supreme Court TECO case. In sum, a deferral will allow the Commission to consider these cases together and will allow the Commission Staff time to draft a comprehensive recommendation which addresses all similar need determination dockets with regard to the TECO decision and the Energy 2020 Study Commission.
