I appreciate you responding so quickly to our telephone conversation. Enclosed please find the check in the amount of \$ 79.50. Below is a breakdown of the check total:

As we discussed, we have not yet operated under the certificate and therefore have not had any revenue generated under the certificate. I am not sure where the prior year balance came from, since we did not get our certificate approved until late December/99. Regardless, we have included this amount in order to clear our account. As I explained to you, we never did receive the assessment fee notice; my guess is that we have been having some problems here at our location with kids vandalizing our mailboxes and this may have prevented us from receiving the notice. In addition, I did notice that the PSC had not yet corrected our zip code. The correct zip code is 34112 not 32112. It's my guess that either one of these issues may have caused our mail not to be delivered. Back in January we did fill out a form and faxed it to the commission in order to get the zip code corrected. Nonetheless, I will be drafting a settlement letter to the commission, as suggested in your letter and will make sure to copy you on it.
