## AMENDATORY ORDER


## BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 21, 2000, we issued Order No. PSC-00-2222-FOF-TP approving an interconnection agreement between Verizon Florida, Inc. and B.D. Webb Enterprise, Inc. d/b/a Quad City Communications. However, due to a scrivener's error, the order stated that B.D. Webb does not currently hold a Florida certificate to provide Alternative Local Exchange (ALEC) service. The Company currently holds ALEC Certificate No. 7455, issued on June 12, 2000. Therefore, Order No. PSC-00-2222-FOF-TP is amended to reflect that B.D. Webb Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Quad City Communications is the holder of a certificate to provide alternative local exchange service in Florida.

Based on the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that Order No. PSC-00-2222-FOF-TP is hereby amended to reflect that B.D. Webb Enterprises, Inc. d/b/a Quad City Communications currently holds an Alternative Local Exchange Certificate in Florida. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-00-2222-FOF-TP is reaffirmed in all other respects.
