Re: Approval of an Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement Negotiated by BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") and North American Associates, LTD pursuant to Sections 251, 252 and 271 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996

Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and North American Associates, LTD are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission an amendment to their negotiated agreement for the interconnection of their networks, the unbundling of specific network elements offered by BellSouth and the resale of BellSouth's telecommunications services to North American Associates, LTD The Commission approved the initial agreement between the companies in Order No. 00-2155-FOF-TP issued November 14, 2000 in Docket 001013-TP. This amendment changes the company's name to Action Communication, Inc.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and North American Associates, LTD within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their agreement.

FIRST AMENDMENT

INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN NORTH AMERICAN SOFTWARE ASSOCIATES, LTD AND BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. DATED NOVEMBER 1, 1999

Pursuant to this Agreement, (the "Amendment") North American Software Associates, LTD and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties," hereby agree to amend that certain CMRS Agreement between the Parties dated November 1, 1999.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises and covenants contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby covenant and agree as follows:

- 1. North American Software Associates, LTD to Action Communication, Inc., a Mississippi corporation. The Interconnection Agreement is hereby amended to reflect the name changes.
- 2. All of the other provisions of the CMRS Interconnection Agreement, dated November 1, 1999 shall remain in full force and effect.
- 3. Either or both of the Parties is authorized to submit this Amendment to each Public Service Commission for approval subject to Section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
