

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On July 12, 1999, when copies of certain portions of staff's working papers regarding FPL's Capacity Cost audit were delivered to the utility at the audit exit conference, the utility requested that these documents be temporarily excepted from public access in accordance with the provisions of Rule 25-22.006(3)(a)(2), Florida Administrative Code (FAC). On July 19, 1999, staff filed document 08553-99 consisting of those specified portions of the audit working papers. These documents are currently held by the Division of Records and Reporting and designated as temporarily exempt from public access.

On August 2, 1999, the utility filed a request pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, FAC, and Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), that selected portions of the working papers prepared by staff during the audit receive confidential classification. The utility's request included highlighted copies (09075-99) and redacted copies (Exhibit B, Document 09074-99) for public use.

Pursuant to Section 119.07, F. S., documents submitted to this Commission are public records. The only exemptions to this law are specific statutory exemptions and exemptions granted by governmental agencies pursuant to the specific terms of a statutory provision. Subsections 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S., provide the following exceptions:

"Proprietary confidential business information means information, regardless of form or characteristics, which is owned or controlled by the person or company, is intended to be and is treated by the person or company as private in that the disclosure of the information would cause harm to the ratepayers or the person's or company's business operations, and has not been disclosed unless disclosed pursuant to a statutory provision, an order of a court or administrative body, or private agreement that provides that the information will not be released to the public. Proprietary confidential business information includes, but is not limited to:....

- (d) Information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms.
- (e) Information related to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information...."

According to Section 366.093, F. S., and Rule 25-22.006, FAC, the utility has the burden of demonstrating that materials qualify for confidential classification. According to Rule 25-22.006, FAC, the utility must meet this burden by demonstrating that the information is proprietary confidential business information, the disclosure of which will cause the utility, the provider of the information or the ratepayer harm.

Staff Analysis of FPL's Request

Analysis of the utility's request and listing of confidential materials reveals the sensitive information presented in the filing consists of contractual data such as:

- 1) Pricing and other terms;
- 2) Payment records; and
- 3) Contractor rates.

FPL witness Osvaldo J. Lom, Supervisor, Purchase Power Administration, Wholesale Services, asserts disclosure of this material would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods or services on favorable terms, or would impair the competitive business of FPL, or impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

Staff Recommendation

Based upon review of the sensitive materials presented in this filing, we recommend the materials be granted a confidential classification on the basis that the materials disclose sensitive contractual and competitive information the release of which would cause harm to the utility or the provider of the information.

To qualify for confidential classification, the information must be held as confidential and not publicly disclosed. FPL witness Lom reports the material has been held as confidential by FPL.


Confidential Classification Period

Section 366.093(4), Florida Statutes, limits the length of confidential protection to 18 months unless, for good cause shown, a longer protection period is appropriate.

FPL has requested that the material be held as confidential for at least 18 months. The utility has also requested that this material be returned to FPL when the Commission no longer needs the information in accordance with the provisions of Section 366.093(4), F.S.

The Commission has recently responded to a utility's request for return of audit information classified as confidential in Commission Order PSC-98-1024-CFO-EG, dated July 28, 1998. The Prehearing Officer's order provided that since Commission audit working papers are retained by the Commission, this material which is confidential also needs to be retained by the Commission for the same period. The Order went on to state; "if prior to the expiration of the confidential time period, FPL wishes to petition for continued confidential classification of this material, it may do so for good cause". Accordingly, we recommend that confidential protection for these materials be granted for 18 months, which would allow a request an extension of this period, as the utility deems necessary.

A detailed recommendation follows identifying each document recommended for a confidential classification.



In Docket No. 990001-EI, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) filed Exhibit MJH-1 to the direct testimony of Mr. Mark J. Hornick on October 1, 1999. TECO simultaneously requested that the Commission treat specific parts of the Exhibit MJH-1 as confidential pursuant to Section 366.093(d) and (e), Florida Statutes.

TECO states that the following information is proprietary confidential business information regarding its 1998 Transportation Market Price Application and 1998 Coal Market Price Application. The disclosure of this information would impair its efforts to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. In addition, public disclosure would harm the competitive interests of its coal supply and transportation affiliates during negotiations with other current and potential customers; thereby, ultimately harming TECO and its customers. This justification applies to the following sections:

Exhibit MJH-1, Document No. 1, Page 2 of 2, Line 1 (labeled "Tampa Electric Weighted Average per ton, Water Transportation Price from All Tampa Electric Coal Sources")

Exhibit MJH-1, Document No. 2, Page 2 of 2, Line 1 (labeled "Tampa Electric Weighted Average per Ton Price of Coal Purchased").

Furthermore, TECO states that the following information is not itself confidential; however, public disclosure of this information would allow the confidential terms and calculations to be derived. Therefore, individuals could circumvent its efforts at keeping the sensitive and proprietary information confidential. This justification applies to the following sections:

Exhibit MJH-1, Document No. 1, Page 2 of 2, Line 3 (labeled "Over/(Under) Benchmark"), Line 5 (labeled "Total Transportation Cost in 1998"), Line 7 (labeled "Total Cost Over/(Under) Benchmark - 1998"), Line 8 (labeled "Prior Years' Cumulative Benefit (1988-1997)") and Line 9 (labeled "Net Benefit for 1988-1998")

Exhibit MJH-1, Document No. 2, Page 2 of 2, Line 3 (labeled "Over/(Under) Benchmark"), Line 5 (labeled "Total Cost in 1998"), and Line 7 (labeled "Total Cost

Memorandum to Cochran Keating October 12, 1999 Page 2

Over/(Under) Benchmark - 1998").

Staff agrees with TECO's request for confidential treatment for these specific parts of Mr. Hornick's exhibit and recommends that the Commission grant confidential status to the information through October 1, 2001. Staff Analysis of FPL's Request

Analysis of the utility's request and listing of confidential materials reveals the sensitive information presented in the filing consists of:

1) Internal audit reports;

FPL witness Rick Del Cueto, Manager, Internal Auditing, reports this information contains internal auditing controls and reports of internal auditors or information relating to reports of internal auditors.

- 2) Purchase order numbers;
- 3) Contractual pricing and other terms;
- 4) Payment records; and
- 5) Contractor rates.

FPL witnesses Robert Lippman, Manager of Fuel Supply & Operations, Kenneth Brockway, Coal Manager of Non-FPL Generation, and Claude Villard, Manager of Nuclear Fuel, assert disclosure of this material would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods or services on favorable terms, or would impair the competitive business of FPL, or impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

Staff Recommendation

Based upon review of the sensitive materials presented in this filing, we recommend the materials be granted a confidential classification on the basis that the materials disclose the contents of internal audit reports or disclose sensitive contractual and competitive information the release of which would cause harm to the utility or the provider of the information.

To qualify for confidential classification, the information must be held as confidential and not publicly disclosed. FPL witnesses Del Cueto, Lippman, Brockway and Villard report the material in their control has been held as confidential by FPL.

Confidential Classification Period

Section 366.093(4), Florida Statutes, limits the length of confidential protection to 18 months unless, for good cause shown, a longer protection period is appropriate.

FPL has requested that the material be held as confidential for at least 18 months. The utility has also requested that this material be returned to FPL when the Commission no longer needs the information in accordance with the provisions of Section 366.093(4), F.S.
