Dear Ms. Quaintance:

The Commission has received your letter dated March 6 concerning the cancellation of P<sub>.</sub>V. Tel's alternative local exchange carrier (ALEC) certificate. You stated that P.V. Tel did no business in Florida in 2000 or 2001.

Commission records show that P.V. Tel has two certificates in Florida. Certificate No. 7336 (TJ264) is the company's interexchange telecommunications carrier (IXC) certificate and No. 7337 (TX324) is the company's ALEC certificate. Both certificates became effective March 2, 2000.

There are two kinds of cancellations. The first is voluntary, which is normally granted if the company is in good standing with the Commission and does not have a past due balance of the Regulatory Assessment Fee (RAF), including statutory penalty and interest charges. The other is involuntary. If a company is <u>not</u> in good standing and has an outstanding balance of the RAF, the Commission normally cancels the certificate on its own motion for a rule violation. It should be noted that any unpaid balance is forwarded to the Comptroller's Office for further collection efforts.

The RAF is assessed if a certificate is active for any one day during a calendar year. The RAF is due by January 30 of each year, unless the 30th falls on a weekend, then the fee is due by the next working day, for the previous year. For example, the 2000 RAF was due by January 30, 2001 and the 2001 RAF is due by January 30, 2002.

According to Commission records, P.V. Tel has not paid the 2000 RAF, including penalty and interest charges for either the ALEC or IXC certificate. If the company owes the minimum amount for the 2000 RAF, the company would owe \$56 for each certificate, or a total of \$112, if the payment was postmarked by March 31. Depending upon when the check is postmarked, penalty and interest charges would continue to accrue.

## 25-24.474 Cancellation of a Certificate.

- (1) The Commission may on its own motion cancel a company's certificate for any of the following reasons:
- (a) Violation of the terms and conditions under which the authority was originally granted;
- (b) Violation of Commission rule or order; or
- (c) Violation of Florida Statutes.
- (2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request.
- (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.
- (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.
- (c) A statement on treatment of customer deposits and final bills.
- (d) Proof of individual customer notice regarding discontinuance of service.
- (3) Cancellation of a certificate shall be ordered subject to the holder providing the information required by subsection (2).
