Furthermore, clarification regarding references to hybrid fiber/copper loops and BellSouth's ability to submit support for costs, if any, associated with tagging xDSL-capable loops should be provided as set forth in the Staff Analysis.

ISSUE 2: Should the Commission grant MCI, AT&T, Covad, and Z-Tel's Joint Motion for Reconsideration?

RECOMMENDATION: The Motion for Reconsideration should be denied as set forth in the Staff Analysis.

ISSUE 3: Should the Commission grant BellSouth's Motion to Conform Staff Analysis and Cost Model Run to Order No. PSC-01-1181-FOF-TP?

RECOMMENDATION: No. The Motion is actually an untimely Motion for Reconsideration. However, staff does recommend that the Commission should, on its own motion, conform the cost model runs to its decisions set forth in the Order.

ISSUE 4: Should this Docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: No. This Docket should remain open to address BellSouth's 120-day filings and Phase III for Verizon and Sprint.
