

This is issue 1 on staff recommendation in DN 980283 (13A) and issue 2 on staff recommendation in DN 980509 (13B). RAR erred by leaving this item off the vote sheet and misnumbered the remaining numbers in item 13B. (Please note the agenda page clearly stated in bold letters "interested persons may participate at Commission's discretion").
