ISSUE 1: Should the Commission impose a penalty of $\$ 5,000$ or cancel Smart City's ALEC Certificate No. 5795 for its apparent failure to provide the Commission access to information pursuant to Section $364.183(1)$, Florida Statutes, Access to Company Records?
RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should impose a penalty of $\$ 5,000$ or cancel Smart City's ALEC Certificate No. 5795 if payment of the imposed penalty, including docket number and company name, is not received by the Commission within 14 calendar days after the issuance of the Consummating Order. The payment of the penalty should be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the Commission's Order is not protested and if payment of the penalty is not received within 14 calendar days after the issuance of the Consummating Order, then Smart City's certificate should be canceled administratively.
