#### COMPLAINT

BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATONS, INC. ("BellSouth"), through its undersigned counsel, hereby files this Complaint against Supra

Telecommunications and Information Systems, Inc. ("Supra") pursuant to Rules 25-22.036(2), 25-22.036(3)(b), and 28-106.201 of the Florida

Administrative Code and Florida Statutes Chapters 350 and 364.

In support of its Complaint, BellSouth avers the following:

I.

BellSouth is an incumbent local exchange company certified by the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") to provide local exchange telecommunications services in Florida. BellSouth's service of process address is

Supra is an alternative local exchange telecommunications company certified by the Commission to provide telecommunications services in Florida. Supra's business address, according to Commission records, is

Supra Telecommunications and Information Systems, Inc. 2620 S. W. 27<sup>th</sup> Avenue Miami, Florida 33133-3005

III.

Pursuant to Section 364.336, Florida Statutes, each telecommunications company regulated under Chapter 364 is required to pay to the Commission a regulatory assessment fee that is composed of a percentage of the Company's annual gross operating revenues derived from intrastate business. Amounts paid to other telecommunications companies for the use of any telecommunications network are deducted from the gross operating revenue for purposes of computing the regulatory assessment fee due. See Section 364.336, Florida Statutes.

IV.

Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code implements Section 364.336, Florida Statutes and requires the filing by Alternative Local Exchange Company Regulatory Assessment Fees Return. Consistent with the statute it implements, the Rule requires that amounts <u>paid</u> to another telecommunications company for use of any telecommunications network to

provide service may be deducted from the gross operating revenues. <u>See</u>

Rule 25-4.0161(1), Florida Administrative Code.

٧.

Supra purchases services and elements from BellSouth in order to provide local exchange telecommunications services to its customers in Florida.

VI.

Attached hereto as Exhibit "A" is a true and correct copy of Supra's Alternative Local Exchange Company Regulatory Assessment Fee Return for the period of January 1, 2000 to December 31, 2000. Attached hereto as Exhibit "B" is a true and correct copy of Supra's Alternative Local Exchange Company Regulatory Assessment Fee Return for the period of January 1, 2001 to December 31, 2001. These filings are matters of public record.

VII.

In its reports required by the statute and the Rule, Supra declared, under penalty of criminal prosecution, to the Commission that it had paid BellSouth \$1,032,596.00 in 2000 and \$23,552,861.00 in 2001 and deducted those amounts from its gross operative revenues for purposes of computing the regulatory assessment fee due. This deduction led to a lower regulatory assessment fee for Supra in 2000 and 2001.

VIII.

On September 27, 2001, in Docket No. 001305-TP, Mr. Olukayode Ramos, President and Chief Executive Officer of Supra, testified under oath that Supra had not paid BellSouth anything for the year 2000 and nothing for the year 2001 as of September 27, 2001. See Exhibit "C".

IX.

Further confirming this fact, attached hereto as Exhibit "D" is the affidavit of Claude Morton which clearly states that Supra did not make any payments to BellSouth in 2000 and did not pay BellSouth \$23,552,861.00 in 2001.

Χ.

This Commission has jurisdiction to enforce its rules and the provisions of Chapter 364 pursuant to Section 350.127 and Section 364.285, Florida Statutes. Moreover, Section 364.337(5), Florida Statutes, grants the Commission authority to ensure the fair treatment of all telecommunications providers in the telecommunications marketplace. In addition, Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes, grants the Commission the authority to impose penalties for willful violations of the Commission rules and orders, and for violation of any provision of Chapter 364.

XI.

As is apparent from the Exhibits attached hereto, Supra has submitted false information to this Commission in connection with its 2000 and 2001 regulatory assessment fee payments. BellSouth's substantial interests have

been affected by Supra's actions. First, the regulatory assessment fees collected by the Commission are for the use of the Commission in performance of its functions and duties. Second, all other regulated Companies are required to abide by the Commission's rules and the precepts of Chapter 364. If Supra is allowed to flout these rules, then all other telecommunications companies, including BellSouth, are treated unfairly and this Commission is financially affected, thereby affecting its regulation of BellSouth.

WHEREFORE, Complainant, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., prays that, after due proceedings that there be judgment herein against Supra as follows:

- (1) Ordering Supra to file correct and accurate Regulatory

  Assessment Fees forms establishing the actual amount of regulatory assessment fees, if any, that Supra paid to BellSouth in 2000 and 2001;
- (2) Ordering Supra to pay all sums due and owing in regulatory assessment fees for years 2000 and 2001;
- (3) Ordering Supra to pay penalties and interest;
- (4) Ordering Supra to pay penalties for violation of theCommission Rules and of Chapter 364, Florida Statutes; and
- (5) For all other relief deemed appropriate under the law.
