2	Q:	Please state your name and address.
3	A:	My name is JoAnn Schneider. My address is Post Office Box 337,
4		Summerfield, Florida 34492-0337.
5		
6	Q:	By whom are you employed?
7	A:	I am currently employed by Monroe Insurance Management Services,
8		Inc.
9		
10	Q:	By whom were you previously employed?
11	A:	Sunshine Utilities of Central Florida, Inc. ("Sunshine").
12		
13	Q:	What is the purpose of your testimony?
14	A:	The purpose of my testimony is to: (i) describe my responsibilities as
15		officer manager for Sunshine from 1984 through June 1997, which
16		included preparation of the utility's Annual Report to be filed with
17		the Florida Public Service Commission (the "Commission"); (ii)
18		explain the entries I made to certain sections of the utility's 1990 and
19		1991 Annual Reports; and (iii) explain the scope and responsibilities
20		of Sunshine's president during the time that I was employed by
21		Sunshine.

23	Q:	Are there any exhibits to your testimony?
24	A:	Yes. I am sponsoring the following exhibits:

8	Q:	When were you emplo	oyed by Sunshine, and in what capacity?
9	A:	I was employed as the	ne Office Manager of Sunshine from 1984
10		through June of 1997.	
11			
12	Q:	What were your dutie	es and responsibilities as Office Manager
13		of Sunshine?	
14	A:	I managed the office and	d was responsible for completing paperwork
15		for the utility, including	groutine filings with the Florida Department
16		of State, Division of Cor	porations, and the Commission.
17			
18	Q:	Did your duties and r	responsibilities include preparing
19		Sunshine's Annual R	eport filed with the Commission?
20	A:	Yes, as Office Manager,	I was responsible for preparing Sunshine's
21		Annual Report each yea	ır.
22			
23	Q:	Did you prepare Sun	shine's Annual Report for the calendar
24 .		year ending Decembe	er 31, 1991?
25	A:	Yes.	

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1	Q:	Who were the officers of Sunshine in 1991?
2	A:	James H. Hodges, Sr. was the president of the utility. His wife,
3		Clarise G. Hodges, was the vice-president.
4		
5	Q:	Was Mr. Hodges working as a full-time employee of Sunshine
6		in 1991?
7	A:	Yes. For the entire duration of my employment with Sunshine, Mr.
8		Hodges always worked full-time for Sunshine in his roles as
9		president, a member of the board of directors, and as an owner of the
10		utility.
11		
12	Q:	Did you complete the portion of Sunshine's 1991 Annual
13		<b>Report addressing compensation of officers?</b>
14	A:	Yes. As I previously stated, one of my duties as Office Manager was
15		to complete Sunshine's Annual Report. A copy of page E-6 from the
16		1991 Annual Report addressing compensation of officers is attached
17		to my testimony as Exhibit (JS-1).
18		
19	Q:	In column (c) of page E-6 of the 1991 Annual Report entitled
20		"% of Time Spent As Officer Of Utility" it states 50% for Mr.
21		Hodges. What does this number reflect?
22	A:	Prior to 1991, Mr. Hodges was the sole owner of Sunshine. However,
23		in 1991, Mr. Hodges gave half of his ownership interest in the utility
24		to his wife and the utility's vice-president, Clarise Hodges. Because
25		Mr. Hodges and Mrs. Hodges each held a 50% interest in the utility, I

1		stated in the Annual Report that they each spent 50% of their time
2		as an officer of the utility.
3		
4	Q:	Was the 50% of the time that you indicated Mr. Hodges spent
5		as an officer of the utility the only time that Mr. Hodges spent
6		working for the utility?
7	A:	No. As I have indicated, the 50% indicated on the Annual Report was
8		a reflection of Mr. Hodges' ownership interest in the utility, and not
9		the amount of time that he was working for the utility. Mr. Hodges
10		worked full-time for the utility during all of the years that I was the
11		utility's Office Manager.
12		
13	Q:	From your perspective, what were Mr. Hodges'
14		responsibilities as president of Sunshine while you were
15		employed by Sunshine?
16	A:	Mr. Hodges had many of the same responsibilities as any traditional
17		corporate officer. For example, he made broad management
18		decisions concerning the utility and conducted meetings of the
19		shareholders. However, Mr. Hodges' duties and work for Sunshine
20		were much more than simply making broad policy decisions
21		concerning the growth and direction of the company. Mr. Hodges
22		was involved in overseeing the operation of the 21 separate water
23		systems that make up the utility. Mr. Hodges was on-call around the
24		clock, throughout the year to respond to any issue that might arise
25		pertaining to the operation of the utility. He was also responsible for

1		managing the utility's finances, working on environmental
2		compliance matters, and dealing with customer service and employee
3		issues.
4		
5	Q:	Did you complete the portion of Sunshine's 1990 Annual
6		<b>Report addressing compensation of officers?</b>
7	A:	Yes. A copy of page E-6 from the 1990 Annual Report addressing
8		compensation of officers is attached to my testimony as Exhibit
9		(JS-2).
10		
11	Q:	In column (c) of page E-6 of the 1990 Annual Report entitled
12		"% of Time Spent As Officer Of Utility" it states 100% for Mr.
13		Hodges. What does this number reflect?
14	A:	As I previously mentioned, in 1990, Mr. Hodges was the sole owner of
15		the utility. The 100% entry on page E-6 was included to reflect Mr.
16		Hodges' 100% ownership interest in Sunshine Utilities.
17		
18	Q:	Did you intend for the 100% in column (c) of page E-6 of the
19		1990 Annual Report to indicate that Mr. Hodges was a full-
20		time employee of the utility?
21	A:	No. Although Mr. Hodges always worked full-time for the utility
22		while I was with Sunshine, I intended for the 100% entry to reflect
23		his ownership interest and not his employment status.

1	Q:	Did Mr. Hodges' responsibilities and functions performed for
2		the utility in 1990 differ from his responsibilities and
3		functions performed for the utility in 1991?
4	A:	No. Mr. Hodges worked full-time for Sunshine in 1991 just as he did
5		in 1990 and in every other year that I worked for Sunshine.
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7	Q:	Does that conclude your direct testimony?
8	A:	Yes.
