THIRD ORDER REVISING ORDER ESTABLISHING PROCEDURE

By Order No. PSC-02-0459-PCO-EI, issued April 3, 2002, an Order Establishing Procedure was issued which established dates to govern the key activities in this proceeding. In particular, Order No. PSC-02-0459-PCO-EI provided for a Commission workshop on May 29, 2002, parties' post-workshop comments to be filed June 21, 2002, and a staff recommendation to be filed July 25, 2002, for consideration at the Commission's August 6, 2002, Agenda Conference.

By Order No. PSC-02-0865-PCO-EI, issued June 25, 2002, Florida Power Corporation, Florida Power & Light Company, and Tampa Electric Company ("Applicants") were granted an extension to file any post-workshop comments addressing market design issues on or before July 5, 2002. Further, that Order allowed intervenors until July 12, 2002, to file their post-workshop comments on market design to address the July 5 comments filed by the Applicants.

To account for the extended filing dates for parties' postworkshop comments on market design issues, additional time shall be provided for filing the staff recommendation in this docket. Accordingly, the staff recommendation in this docket shall now be filed by August 8, 2002, for consideration at the Commission's August 20, 2002, Agenda Conference. Order No. PSC-02-0459-PCO-EI is affirmed in all other respects.

Based upon the foregoing, it is

ORDERED by Chairman Lila A. Jaber, as Prehearing Officer, that Order No. PSC-02-0459-PCO-EI is hereby revised as set forth in the body of this Order. It is further

ORDERED that Order No. PSC-PSC-02-0459-PCO-EI is affirmed in all other respects.

Mediation may be available on a case-by-case basis. If mediation is conducted, it does not affect a substantially interested person's right to a hearing.

Any party adversely affected by this order, which is preliminary, procedural or intermediate in nature, may request: (1) reconsideration within 10 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.0376, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by a Prehearing Officer; (2) reconsideration within 15 days pursuant to Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code, if issued by the Commission; or (3) judicial review by the Florida Supreme Court, in the case of an electric, gas or telephone utility, or the First District Court of Appeal, in ORDER NO. the case of a water or wastewater utility. A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of the Commission Clerk and Administrative Services, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
