Dear Ms. Bayo:

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This letter is in response to Patti Daniel's July 11, 2002, correspondence requesting certain information in connect with the above-referenced docket. The Utility provides the following responses:

- 1. On July 24, 2002, Burkim Enterprises, Inc., filed an Amended Territory Description to eliminate those properties for which the description was incorrect. Based on discussions with Staff, this eliminates any renoticing requirements.
- 2. Enclosed are copies of current financial statements for Burkim Enterprises, Inc., which along with prior information provided in this Docket is sufficient to prove Burkim Enterprises, Inc.'s financial ability.
- 3. The system maps provided to the Commission Staff did not note proposed water and wastewater lines since the lines to serve the existing territory are already in place. The one line to the single-family dwelling DOCUMENT NUMBER-DATE

> north of the wastewater treatment plant will be installed by the property owner wholly within his property and will only require connections at the plant site.

- 4. Burkim Enterprises, Inc., believes that with the Amendment to the Territory to eliminate certain property because of incorrect legal descriptions, eliminates the problems which Staff has noted with the inability to correlate the legal description to the map.
- 5. As noted, the Commission in Burkim Enterprises, Inc.'s SARC, which was concluded by Order No. PSC-012511-PAA-WS, the Utility's water treatment plant was rated at 100% capacity. That determination was made taking into consideration the currently served portion of the Territory Amendment and included customer growth. Thus, the only portion of the proposed Territory that was not included in that analysis is for the single-family residence to the north of the current service area which can be included within the 17 ERCs of customer growth as included in the Utility's SARC. Further, the repairs to the distribution system are reducing the unaccounted for water which allows for further capacity for potable water use.
- 6. No permit will be required for the property upon which the single-family home is located since the connection to the existing system will be made by the customer through service laterals.
- 7. This Application will not require the Utility to build a new wastewater treatment plant nor upgrade the existing plant. Effluent disposal is currently through percolation ponds.
- 8. The Utility does not provide reuse since the wastewater treatment plant does not produce sufficient wastewater flow to allow for permitting for reclaimed water.

As the Staff has noted on several occasions, including in the Order resulting from the Utility's recent SARC, the problem with fire-flow and pressure was a direct result of the fact that there was no hydroneumatic tank in operation. As the Staff is aware, there is a new hydroneumatic tank providing constant water pressure utilizing three high service pumps. The Brevard County Fire Marshall made his original inspection as a result of residents' complaints as a result of the Utility filing for a Ms. Blanca Bayo August 12, 2002 Page 3

SARC, and although the alleged problems noted have been corrected, the Fire Marshall has not taken it upon himself to reevaluate the system nor can the Utility force him to do.
