PETITION FOR APPROVAL OF FLORIDA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPANY'S CONSERVATION COST RECOVERY FACTORS

Florida Public Utilities Company ("the Company"), through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to the requirements of this docket, hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the Company's conservation cost recovery factors for each of its two electric divisions for the period January, 2003 through December, 2003. In support hereof, the Company states:

- 2) The name and address of the person authorized to receive notices and communications with respect to this Petition are:

- 3) Pursuant to the requirements of this Docket, the Company has prefiled the conservation cost recovery forms supplied by the Electric & Gas Department in a manner consistent with the Department's instructions.
- 4) As indicated in the prefiled forms, the recoverable conservation costs for the period January 2003 through December 2003 are projected to be \$237,600 for the Marianna division and

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\$228,000 for the Fernandina Beach division. The conservation cost recovery true-up amount for the

period January 2002 through December 2002 is \$5,088 for the Marianna division and (\$22,933) for

the Fernandina Beach division.

5) The resulting net total projected conservation costs to be recovered for the period

January 2003 through December 2003 are \$242,688 for the Marianna division and \$205,067 for the

Fernandina Beach division. Based upon projected sales for each respective division the appropriate

levelized conservation cost recovery factors for the period January 2003 through December 2003 are

\$.00079 for the Marianna division and \$.00049 for the Fernandina Beach division.

WHEREFORE, Florida Public Utilities Company petitions the Commission to approve the

foregoing conservation cost recovery factors, to be applied to customer bills for the period January,

2003 through December, 2003, and to billings thereafter until other conservation cost recovery

factors are approved by the Commission.
