#### **REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION**

GULF POWER COMPANY ["Gulf Power", "Gulf", or the "Company"], by and through its undersigned attorney and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, hereby files a request that the Florida Public Service Commission enter an order protecting from public disclosure Gulf Power's Risk Management Plan for Fuel Procurement. As grounds for this request, the Company states:

1. On September 19, 2002, Gulf submitted its Risk Management Plan for Fuel Procurement under a Notice of Intent to Request Confidential Classification. This information is entitled to confidential classification pursuant to §366.093(3)(a) and (e), Florida Statutes, as information, the public disclosure of which would cause irreparable harm to the competitive interests of Gulf Power and the ability of Gulf to enter into contracts on terms favorable to it and its ratepayers. The information for which confidential classification is sought is intended to be and is treated by Gulf Power Company as private and is not otherwise publically available.

2. Gulf Power Company's Risk Management Plan for Fuel Procurement contains proprietary and commercially sensitive information regarding Gulf Power, which if disclosed to the general public would cause irreparable harm to Gulf Power. Specifically, the Risk Management Plan for Fuel Procurement contains, in a single resource, detailed information about Gulf's fuel procurement in the near term and into the future. This information is entitled to

Gulf and other members of the market in which it competes for fuel and fuel transportation, and fuel storage consider this type of information to be trade secret and competitively sensitive. This information discusses how Gulf manages its fuel procurement with specific information regarding Gulf's fuel needs, market position, trends it sees in those markets in which it addresses its fuel needs and the Company's possible reactions to various market events and conditions. In addition, the strategy employed by Gulf or on its behalf in the procurement of fuel are discussed in great detail. Gulf's competitors are not required to disclose this information or information similar to it such that Gulf could gain the same competitive advantage that its competitors would gain from this information if it were made public. Moreover, fuel suppliers can use this information to Gulf's disadvantage in negotiations for fuel and fuel transportation which would result in detriment to Gulf's ratepayers. Disclosure of this information would adversely affect Gulf's ability to manage its fuel procurement in a manner that secures the best price and terms for its customers fuel needs.

3. Portions of the information at various parts of Gulf Power Company's Risk Management Plan for Fuel Procurement are already the subject of either a pending request for confidential classification or an order granting such a request. This information continues to be regarded as confidential for the reasons set forth in those filings or orders.

4. The information filed pursuant to this Request is intended to be, and is treated as, confidential by the Gulf and has not been otherwise publicly disclosed.

5. Submitted as Exhibit "A" is a copy of the Risk Management Plan for Fuel Procurement, on which is highlighted the information for which confidential classification is

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requested. Exhibit "A" should be treated as confidential pending a ruling on this request. Attached as Exhibit "B" are two (2) edited copies of the Risk Management Plan for Fuel Procurement, which may be made available for public review and inspection. Attached as Exhibit "C" to this request is a line-by-line/field-by-field justification for the request for confidential classification.

WHEREFORE, Gulf Power Company respectfully requests that the Commission enter an order protecting the information highlighted on Exhibit "A" from public disclosure as proprietary confidential business information.
