REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION

UTILITIES, INC. ("UI"), by and through its undersigned attorneys and pursuant to Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code and Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, hereby requests confidential classification of certain work papers provided by UI in connection with the audit of this matter.

- 1. The information which UI seeks to be classified as confidential falls within two classifications: internal analysis of utility acquisitions, and specific salary information of employees at the parent company level.
- 2. The disclosure of UI's schedule of utility acquisitions would impair UI's negotiations for the purchase of utility systems in the future. A prospective seller of a utility system to UI could utilize this information in determining how much UI would be willing to pay for the utility system, and thus be an impediment to UI's goal of purchasing utility systems at the lowest possible price.
- 3. The disclosure of specific salary information of UI employees would have an adverse effect on employee moral and would hinder UI's ability to hire and retain employees at competitive partwent North Competitive

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salaries. This is why in private businesses employee salary information generally remains confidential.

4. Attached are copies of the documents in question, one with the information highlighted and one with it redacted.

WHEREFORE, Utilities, Inc., requests this Commission find and determine that the referenced audit work papers are entitled to confidential treatment pursuant to Section 367.156, Florida Statutes, and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, and exempt from public disclosure.
