


1. Commission staff has requested BellSouth to allow Commission staff and witnesses in this docket to tour certain BellSouth central offices (see attached Memorandum). Parties to the docket are also entitled to participate in the tours. Certain information that can be obtained during the tours constitutes confidential and proprietary business information as the term is defined in § 364.183, F.S. Such confidential and proprietary business information may include, but is not limited to, information in written, oral, photographs or other tangible or intangible form, including information obtained during observation, that depicts, reflects, or constitutes the type, quantity, location and use or non-use of telecommunications equipment or facilities that BellSouth or any other entity has placed on BellSouth's property, or information concerning the number, identity or location of customers that BellSouth or any other entity serves or


anticipates serving from said telecommunications equipment or facilities. Such information affects BellSouth's or its customers' competitive interests, the disclosure of which could impair their competitive business interests.

Because participation in the tours allows participants, including Commission staff and consultants, access to confidential and proprietary business information of BellSouth, BellSouth is filing this Notice of Intent to Request Specified Confidential Classification pursuant to Rule 25-22.006(3)(a), F.A.C., to allow the tours to proceed without delay.
