INDEMNITY BOND TO THE PEOPLE OF THAT STATE OF FLORIDA

The principal will promptly obtain a bond by an admitted surety carrier before the end of the thirty (30) day period for an amount equal to or greater than the value of this instrument unless the Obligee and the Principal agree otherwise.
