ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. If no person whose substantial interests are affected files a protest within 21 days of the issuance date of the order, the order should become final upon the issuance of a consummating order. If the order is protested, the procedures enumerated in the analysis portion of staff's August 25, 2003 memorandum should govern subsequent actions in this docket.
