FROM: Shevie Brown, Regulatory Analyst, Division of Competitive Markets and Enforcement 500 n Docket No. 030990-TL, BellSouth Telecommunications Inc. (BellSouth) Petition for RE: Expedited Review of a Growth Code Denial by NANPA for Gainesville (Gainesville Main).

On October 16, 2003, BellSouth filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn NANPA's decision to deny a growth code in the Gainesville Main switch (GSVLFLMADS1) located in the Gainesville rate center. In accordance with Commission Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL (Docket No. 010782-TL) which approved an expedited process for code denials, we have examined the BellSouth petition, along with the confidential supplemental information, and have determined the following:

- The carrier has demonstrated that it has a specific customer in need of 1) immediate numbering resources;
- The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to the 2) potential customer because of NANPA's denial of numbering resources; and
- The potential customer cannot obtain service from the provider of its choice 3) because the carrier does not have numbers available to fulfill the customer's needs.

Since the three required criteria of Order PSC-01-1973-PCO-TL have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action (PAA) Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (November 6, 2003) as outlined in the expedited code denial process order. NANPA should be directed to provide BellSouth the needed numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the Gainesville Main switch (GSVLFLMADS1), specifically, an NXX of ten thousand numbers, since this is not a pooling area. The BellSouth customer has requested five hundred consecutive numbers in the format 352-XX8. Please be sure to allow staff assigned to the docket to review the Order before it is issued.
